Pre-Defined Screens


Click on any of the pre-defined screen options to start the screening process.






Review Screening Results

Preview a small graph of sales, earnings and price by clicking on the Preview Data _____ icon.

Click on any column heading to **sort** the results.



Click on any row or on the Start Study icon to open a company in CoreSSG or SSGPlus.





Ticker Heat Map (only available in SSGPlus)

Click on the image to open the Ticker Heat Map, which displays the top 100 company SSGs created by our members in the last 90 days.

Mouse over any box to see more information.



The size of the box indicates relative popularity.

Larger box = more SSGs created.

The color of the box indicates relative return favorability.

Darker green = more favorable return.

Darker red = less favorable
