

BI CA Chapters Reference for Digital Value Line:

Some Public Libraries with Digital Value Line Access

For CA residents: Start with your local library first, then go to one of the following California libraries next.

Non-residents: Phone during library hours. "Showing proper identification" means you need to go to the library in person with your photo ID showing your address.

All: Verify current Library Card rules *at a specific library's website*. We don't know all California libraries with remote access to Value Line. And rules do change. Version: as of 10/20/2023

You can view different components of a module (Quarterly, Annual, Charts, or data, etc.) and Customize, Print, or Download a report. Buttons, tabs, and hyperlinks are inconsistent from module to module and sometimes within the same module. Be brave. Explore.

Module Name	Max. # of Columns: Module Description and Actions for Additional Company Information
*Ranks	2: From 2 col.: Compare Company to Peers, Industry for Safety, Timeliness Ranks. Cursor over to see names.
*Financial Strength Grade Rating	2: From 2 col. Grade Rating (From A++ to C in 9 steps) with Industry (1 column) and with Peers & Industry (2 Column) hover over Peers, Industry. Compares Company to VL Universe. Use to reference peers for an industry study. THEN open the peers to use for the study. Use the navigation buttons and the CURRENT LIST. Expand to Customize Report.
*Commentary	3: Expand. Scroll Commentary/rank/rating changes by quarter for curr. calendar year. Supplement info. Print.
3-5 year Projections	2: Displays price projection, price appreciation potential, and annual total return projection vs. Russell 2000.
*Valuation	3: Expand. Displays 5-year to 10-year Industry financial ratios. See the module scroll buttons (last button to Expand).
*Earnings	2: From 2 columns, display 8 Quarters (3 historical, 5 est.) and 5 years Annual (3 historical, 2 est.) EPS + more...
Sales	2: Displays 10 Quarters (6 historical, 4 projected) or 3 Annual (2 historical, 1 projected) (bug: no Annual chart display)
Total Return %	2: Displays 1yr, 3yr, 5yr returns for price appreciation + dividends=Total Return for Company, 1+ peer. Bug?
Annual Rates of Change	1: Compare Earnings, Book Value, and Dividends to (one) growth rate period: 6 choices: 3 historical, 3 projections.
Score Ratings	2: From 2 col: Compare Company to Peers/Industry for Price Stability, Price Growth Persistence, Earnings Predictability
*Peers	1: Compare to heat map or Peers List. Valuation, Rank & Ratings, and Table tabs. Expand Table Tab with View all. Print.
*Industry Analysis	3: Expand. Industry Commentary/Rank. Compare TTM relative strength to Industry+Heat Map. Bug?. List of Companies
*Insider Transactions	3: Expand. Drop-down arrow for name selection. View more transactions. Print. Remember: "step sequence"
Institutional Ownership	2: Expand. Transaction and Top 10 Institutional Holder Tab or hyperlink.
Business Overview	1: Company Description & History tabs.
Technical Rank	1: Displays 3-6 months future price returns relative to the Value Line universe.
*Value Line PDF Reports	3: Expand. Shows 2 years' worth of quarterly Company, Industry, Selection & Opinion, Summary & Index (pdf) reports.
*(HIDDEN) CHARTING	3: a) From 1 Col. Show Data. Download (Historical Prices) Print b) Expand. Configure with menus. Customize Date Range. c Show Value Line Chart. > Valuation > Print. d) Show Value Line Projections
