He is the Chairman of the S&P Investment Policy Committee, where he focuses on market history and valuations, as well as industry momentum strategies. Sam is the author of *The Seven Rules of Wall Street*, as well as *The Standard & Poor's Guide to Sector Investing*. He writes a weekly investment piece on S&P Capital IQ's MarketScope Advisor platform. His work is also found in S&P's flagship weekly newsletter *The Outlook*.
