Generating High-Quality First Cut Stock Studies Excerpt

The Houston Chapter has been very successful in the last 2 years with the First Cut Challenge and here are a few take aways from their achievements. The full article can be accessed from the Houston Model Club. More than driving a contest, providing First Cuts gives beginning members examples to study, and give experienced members a second opinion.

Their approach has been simple: document what they are already doing! Their model club includes a Stock to Study each month, and they made it part of the process to prepare a First Cut of that stock. The Houston Chapter also communicated this idea to the clubs in their Chapter whenever they held events. They accelerated this idea, as their model club moved its stock to study into industry studies each month. This process generated multiple ideas for the club and their audience, as well as giving the club members more chances to do SSG's and present them.

They also got practice with the Stock Comparison guide when they hold a vote on which company, they consider the best investment. If you are preparing a Stock to Study or industry study for your club, you are already doing all the work required for a First Cut. The First Cut also serves to record your judgments for your own future reference. If you aren't already documenting your reasoning to support your SSG's, consider using the [First Cut form](#), for your own benefit and for the entire community!

Houston's first place standing in last year's Challenge is the result of broad-based participation from their full chapter membership. Half their submissions were from the general membership, the other half from their model club. And 40% of the submitters are not volunteers. This reflects very well on the energy that the Houston Chapter is devoting to supporting their chapter members.



The Definitive Book on Value Investing
Benjamin Graham*

The key lesson from Benjamin Graham’s much-lauded tome: “Don’t lose.” Easier said than done, of course. So read on. The reason why this book, originally published in 1949, is still in print is that it offers investors—be they beginners, those with some knowledge and success, or old hands—the nuts and bolts of [value investing](#), which is buying stocks of quality companies whose worth is [undervalued](#). The practice is akin to buying a finely made piece of furniture at a discount. It was most recently updated in 2006. “Investing means simply being patient, disciplined, and eager to learn; you must also be able to harness your emotions and think for yourself,” he writes.
