
From the President

BOOK IT!

Competitive Strategy: Techniques for Analyzing Industries and Competitors by Michael E. Porter

If you are looking to increase your understanding of how to analyze a company's performance and competitive advantage, this book is for you. It provides a framework companies can use to look at their rivals and assess their competition, which has been termed Qualitative Analysis. For us as investors, Porter's Five Forces gives insight on how we can review things like management, business cycles, research and development and competitive advantage. The Stock Selection Guide® (SSG®) contains a wealth of quantitative data or data that can be measured. Historical sales, earnings per share and price-earnings ratios are examples of quantitative data. Qualitative analysis helps us understand the quantitative data, addressing the how and why of past and future performance. (If you're interested in this topic you might

also be interested in a recent StockUp presentation: <u>How to Use Qualitative Factors in Fundamental Analysis</u>)
