

Value Line access online

All Pennsylvania residents have free access to the *Free Library of Philadelphia*, including Value Line online.



To access the Library, go to: <http://www.freelibrary.org>

You will need a *Free Library of Philadelphia* card. Click in the upper right corner of the home page to sign up for one.




After your Pennsylvania residency is verified, you will receive an email with your library card number.

To access the Library web site, you need to log in, using your library card number plus a PIN number of your choice.

To access Value Line Online, go to: <http://libwww.freelibrary.org/databases/index.cfm>

Log in, then click on the “V” in the alphabet display in the lower part of the page. Click on *Value Line*, which will appear below it, to the left.



Once you are on the Value Line home page, click *DASHBOARD* in the menu. You can then navigate using the *Quick Links* in the box on the right.

A hint for easier access after you become comfortable with getting into Value Line through the Library interface:

If you use a Password Manager like LastPass (or similar), you should be able to set it up to enter your library card # and PIN, and go directly to Value Line using this URL: <http://libwww.freelibrary.org/elecrs/valueline.cfm>

Don't forget to Sign Out when you are through using Value Line.
