

Sir John Templeton, a respected investment counselor, and portfolio manager, once stated, "The stock market always has been, and always will be, subject to wide degrees of fluctuations. When prices decline farther and farther, it is only natural human emotion to become cautious. Investors who have no prearranged plan to guide them not only fail to add to their stock holdings at the lower levels, but too frequently they add to the downward pressure by selling out part or all the stocks they own.

Profitable investing is mainly common sense. Don't get carried away by enthusiasm. Don't get carried away by despondency. Don't buy things you don't understand. Always study what you buy in advance. Make long-range plans. Know in advance that you are going to have to live through bear markets. Just use plain common sense and the chances are that you'll have superior long-term investment performance."

Many of these truths are heard regularly at our online events, the BetterInvesting National Convention, and in our chapter classes. What we're going through is not unlike other periods of financial history. BetterInvesting members have understood this since the time of its inception in 1951. We have a plan and it is rooted in the common sense principles provided by the organization's founders. These principles include:

- 1. Invest a set amount of money regularly.
- 2. Reinvest all earnings.
- 3. Buy stock in high-quality growth companies.
- 4. Diversify your portfolio.

We spend most of our energy implementing the third principle: looking for high-quality companies and determining a fair price to pay for the company's stock. We do this using the Stock Selection Guide (SSG). Regardless of the type of market we're currently in, long-term investors should continue seeking stocks of high-quality growth companies, which are trading at historically attractive valuations. The recent severe drops we have experienced in the market can result in just that - attractive valuations. We cannot draw any fixed conclusions about the effects of pandemics upon stock-market performance, but I am confident we will get through this, and the long term investor will be rewarded for staying the course. Innovation, technology, and the indomitable human spirit will win in the end.

IT'S A SCAM! It's open season for all scammers and cyber attackers, and there are plenty of opportunities for them to hunt you down. Learn how you can protect yourself to prevent being hurt by their cunning methods. Here are some tips to help keep your email, investment, and other online accounts safe:

- 1. Use a reputable password manager and two-factor authentication (2FA) wherever possible.
- 2. If signing up for a new email service, check for 2FA support; an extra layer of security.
- 3. Don't click on suspicious links in emails or texts. Malware is often attached.
- 4. Be anonymous by using a VPN (Virtual Private Network) on your computer or phone to encrypt Internet connections.
- 5. Don't use public Wi-Fi or public computers if you can help it.
- 6. Get a strong antivirus program installed on all your devices.
- 7. Secure your router and Wi-Fi with strong passwords.
- 8. Keep your computer and smartphone operating systems up to date.
- 9. Keep all your computer and smartphone apps updated for the latest security improvements.
- 10. Consider putting a credit freeze on your account.

Assume that email is NOT secure, even after taking these precautions. Avoid sending highly sensitive information such as payment or credit card data, Social Security numbers and other identifiable information over email if at all possible. Don't make it easy for hackers and scammers to find you. Be armed.

DID YOU KNOW ... a one-time

\$500 deposit invested in a broadmarket equity ETF (or other stock investment vehicle) at the average rate of 8% return per year, compounded annually for 67 years will yield **\$86,768.41**. Age 67 was used because that's the current Social Security retirement age. This one-time deposit could be in the form of a gift for Baby, hence using 67 vears. What a nice legacy for that newborn. Think about what the amount would be if compounded more often than annually, and at a rate of return greater than 8%. Yes, think about it.

Compound Interest Formula

Compound interest - meaning that the interest you earn each year is added to your principal, so that the balance doesn't merely grow, it grows at an increasing rate - is one of the most useful concepts in finance. It is the basis of everything from a <u>personal savings plan</u> to the long term growth of the stock market. It also accounts for the <u>effects of inflation</u>, and the <u>importance of paying down your debt</u>.
