Definition: Valuation is a quantitative process of determining the fair value of an asset, investment, or firm.

Intrinsic Value One of the primary assumptions behind fundamental analysis is that a stock's current price often does not fully reflect the value of the company when compared to publicly available financial data. A second assumption is that the value reflected from the company's fundamental data is more likely to be closer to the true value of the stock.

In general, a company can be valued on its own on an absolute basis, or else on a relative basis compared to other similar companies or assets.

- There are several methods and techniques for arriving at a valuation—each of which may produce a different value. Valuations
- can be quickly impacted by corporate earnings or economic events that force analysts to retool their valuation models.
- While quantitative in nature, valuation often involves some degree of subjective input or assumptions.

Definition: **Fundamental analysis** (FA) measures a security's intrinsic value by examining related economic and financial factors. Intrinsic value is the value of an investment based on the issuing company's financial situation and current market and economic conditions.

Fundamental analysts study anything that can affect the security's value, from macroeconomic factors such as the state of the economy and industry conditions to microeconomic factors like the effectiveness of the company's management.

The end goal is to determine a number that an investor can compare with a security's current price to see whether the security is undervalued or overvalued by other investors.

- If the fair market value is higher than the market price, the stock is deemed undervalued, and a buy recommendation is given.

- In contrast, technical analysts favor studying the historical price trends of the stock to predict short-term future trends.
