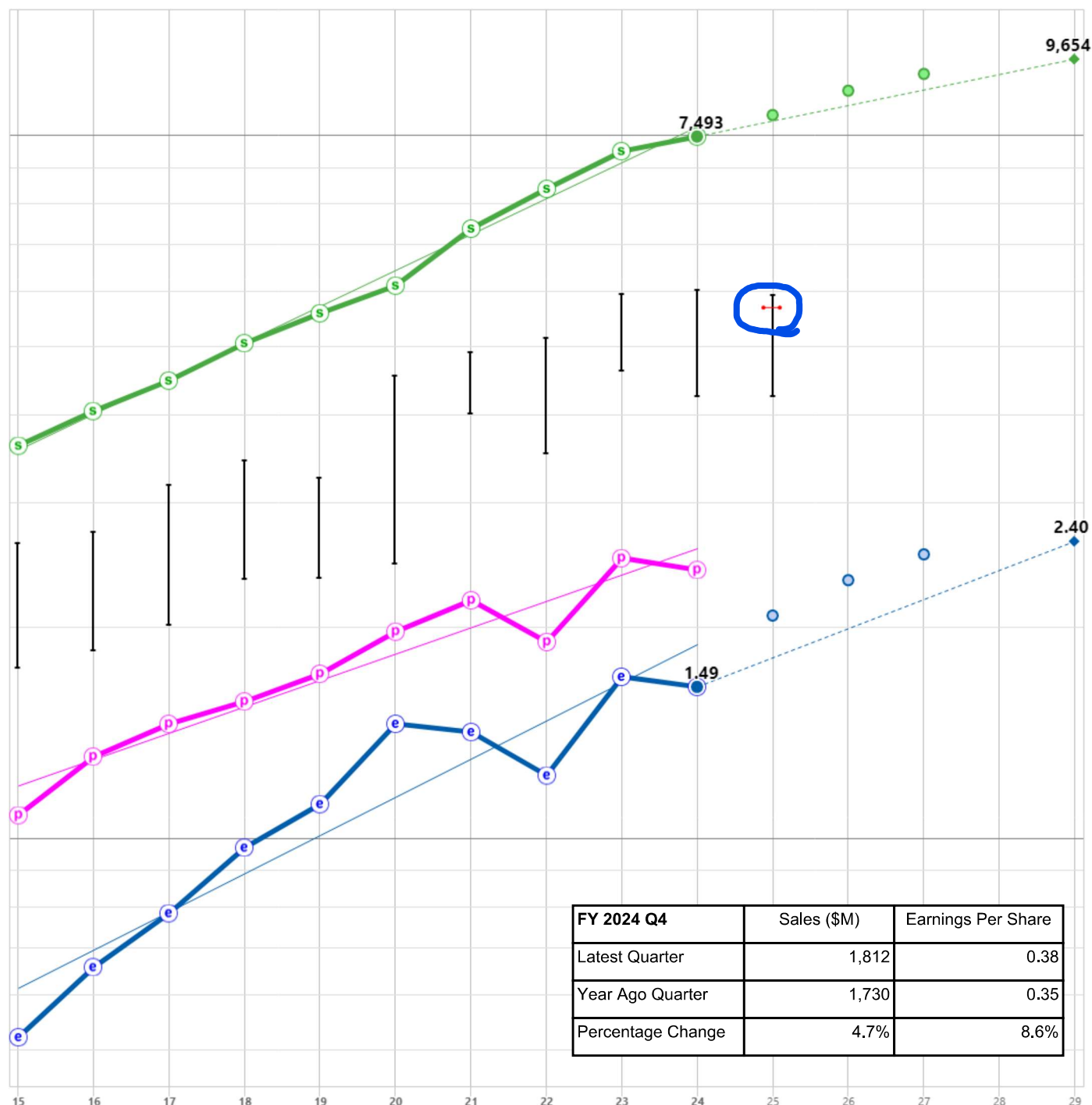

## 4 EVALUATING RISK and REWARD over the next 5 years

Assuming one recession and one business boom every 5 years, calculations are made of how high and how low the stock might sell. The upside-downside ratio is the key to evaluating risk and reward.

### A HIGH PRICE - NEXT 5 YEARS

Avg. High P/E 34.4 X Estimate High Earnings/Share 2.40 = Forecasted High Price \$ 82.6

### B LOW PRICE - NEXT 5 YEARS

(a) Avg. Low P/E 28.5 X Estimate Low Earnings/Share 1.59 = Forecasted Low Price \$ 45.3

(b) Avg. Low Price of Last 5 Years 38.4

(c) Recent Market Low Price 43.3

(d) Price Dividend Will Support  $\frac{\text{Indicated Dividend}}{\text{High Yield}} = \frac{0.00}{0.00\%} = 0.0$

Selected Forecasted Low Price \$ 45.3

### C ZONING using 25%-50%-25%

Forecasted High Price 82.6 Minus Forecasted Low Price 45.3 = 37.3 Range. 25% of Range 9.3

Buy Zone 45.3 to 54.6

Hold Zone 54.6 to 73.2

Sell Zone 73.2 to 82.6

Present Market Price of 57.95 is in the **HOLD** Zone

### D UPSIDE DOWNSIDE RATIO (POTENTIAL GAIN VS. RISK OR LOSS)

$\frac{\text{High Price} - \text{Current Price}}{\text{Current Price} - \text{Low Price}} = \frac{82.6 - 57.95}{57.95 - 45.3} = \frac{24.61}{12.65} = 1.9$  To 1

### E PRICE TARGET (Note: This shows the potential market price appreciation over the next five years in simple interest terms.)

$\frac{\text{High Price} - \text{Current Price}}{\text{Current Price}} = \frac{82.6 - 57.95}{57.95} = 0.4247 \times 100 = 42.47 - 100 = 42.5\%$  % Appreciation

## 5 5-YEAR POTENTIAL

This combines price appreciation with dividend yield to get an estimate of total return. It provides a standard for comparing income and growth stocks.

**A**  $\frac{\text{Indicated Annual Dividend}}{\text{Current Price}} = \frac{0.00}{57.95} = 0.0000 = 0.0\%$  Current Yield

### B AVERAGE YIELD - USING FORECAST HIGH P/E

$\frac{\text{Avg. \% Payout}}{\text{Forecast High PE}} = \frac{0.0\%}{34.40} = 0.0\%$

### AVERAGE YIELD - USING FORECAST AVERAGE P/E

$\frac{\text{Avg. \% Payout}}{\text{Forecast Average PE}} = \frac{0.0\%}{31.45} = 0.0\%$

### C COMPOUND ANNUAL RETURN - USING FORECAST HIGH P/E

Annualized Appreciation 7.3 %
