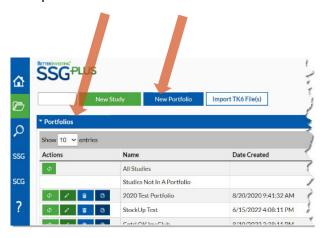


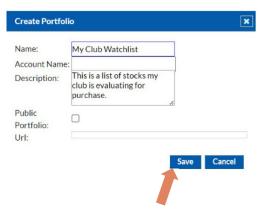

How to Add a Portfolio

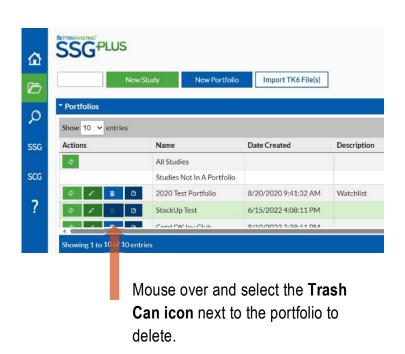
Select the **Portfolio** bar to expand the portfolio list and select 'New Portfolio'.

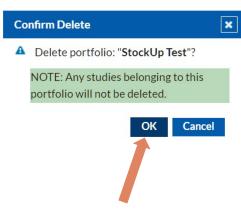




Name your portfolio, fill in Account Name (optional) and Description (optional) and select 'Save'

Select '**OK**' to confirm. Only the portfolio name is deleted. The SSG studies are still in your account and are not deleted.

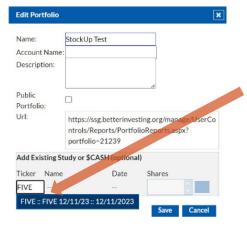

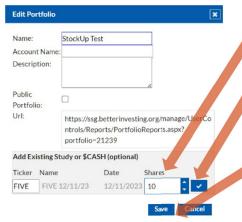
How to Add a Study to a Portfolio and Add Shares





Enter the ticker of your study and pick the correct study from your study list or enter \$CASH to enter cash.

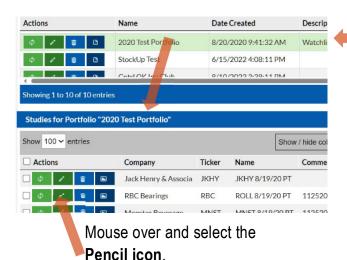
Select the **Pencil icon**.



Enter the number of shares (optional) and select the **Check icon** to accept your changes.

Repeat for all company studies in the portfolio. Select 'Save' to save your changes.

How to Select a Portfolio and Edit the Number of Shares

Edit the Share value and select 'Save'.

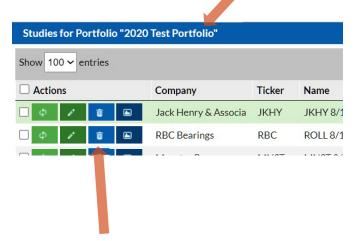

How to Delete a Study from a Portfolio

IMPORTANT: Make sure you have first selected the correct portfolio.



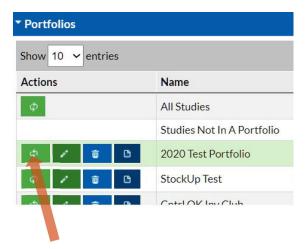
Mouse over and select the **Trash Can Icon** next to the study to delete.



Select '**OK**' to confirm. By default the study is just removed from the portfolio and not deleted permanently.

Choose to update all financial data and prices or update prices only. Select '**OK**' to confirm.

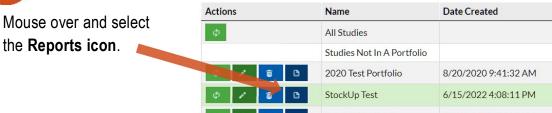

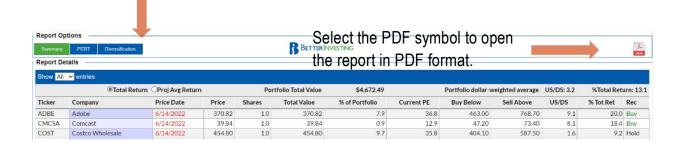

How to Run a Portfolio Report

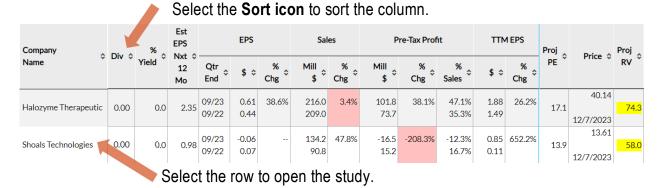

Report Options



- Red 'price date' text indicates the price data is > 7 days old.
- Dashed lines in a cell indicate the study is not completed with all judgments.
- Pink highlighting on the PERT report indicates that the latest quarter change is not meeting your projections.
- PERT report field 'Proj RV' is highlighted in yellow if the value is < 80 or > 150
- PERT report field 'U/D Ratio' is highlighted in yellow if the value is < 1
- PERT report field '% Total Return' is highlighted in yellow if the value is < 10%
